ment's academic staff after examination of the application and depending on available places. A note of acceptance will be sent by email to the student and his/her exchange coordinator within a month after the

application deadline.

FEES Students accepted as part of an exchange programme don't pay

registration fees, as their school of origin had paid for their tuition.

CREDIT SYSTEM (ECTS) At the end of their studies at the École nationale supérieure des Art visuels

de La Cambre, exchange students receive an attestation as well as a trans-

cript of grades and credits corresponding to each teaching unit.

ACCOMMODATION Our school does not have on-campus accommodation. To help students

find accommodation during their stay in Brussels, we send them before they arrive a list of websites with offers for shared apartments rentals.
